About the University

Newcastle University is a public research university with overseas campuses in Singapore and Malaysia. The university is a red brick university and a member of the Russell Group, an association of research-intensive UK universities. This year Newcastle ranked first in the UK and eighth in the world for sustainable development in the Times Higher Education Impact Rankings.

Requirements/Eligibility

- Open to all majors
- Required GPA: 2.8
- Students must have completed at least 12 hours of coursework at UF
- One letter of recommendation
- Submission of official UF transcript
- Statement of Purpose essay
- Meet with Dr. Brian Harfe, CLAS Associate Dean

Location

Newcastle has a rich culture of sports, local music, and history. It's also home to a thriving theatrical arts and literature scene. Historic buildings house a mix of cocktail bars, pubs, theatres and galleries. They showcase the finest local art, gyms, and so much more. All within walking distance of our city-centre campus. Housing

You won't share a bedroom in Newcastle – all of their rooms are designed for single occupancy living and combine sleeping and study space. Each bedroom comes equipped with a bed, a desk, a chair, a wardrobe and shelving. Some rooms have ensuite bathrooms but if not, you'll share a bathroom with approximately 4-6 other students in your 'flat'. You will also share a communal space and kitchen area with your new 'flatmates'.

Application Deadlines

Fall: early May

Academic Year: early May

Spring: mid October

Note: Some exchange programs have earlier deadlines

Tuition

Tuition at the host school is waived for exchange students, who instead pay tuition directly to the University of Florida at their usual tuition rate.

Financial Aid

University of Florida students needing financial aid should apply through UF Student Financial Affairs. Normal eligibility for aid may be used while studying abroad as an exchange student. This includes using the Bright Futures scholarship and the Florida Pre-Paid College Plan.

Scholarships

For fall, spring, and academic-year scholarships administered by the University of Florida International Center, the deadlines for application are: early March for programs starting in fall; and early October for programs starting in spring. Applications are located on the UF International Center website, www.internationalcenter.ufl.edu.

Health Insurance

Students will be billed for mandatory international health insurance which includes emergency medical assistance.

Fees Due

A \$425 non-refundable fee is required within seven days of applying online. Students who will receive financial aid may contact the University of Florida International Center to arrange deferment until the disbursement of their financial aid.
