What is the Pre-Health Scholars (PHS) Program?

Beyond120 (B120) offers a Pre-Health Scholars (PHS) program for pre-health students in the College of Liberal Arts & Science (CLAS). The purpose of the program is to provide pre-health students an opportunity to focus on humanities and social sciences, by providing a foundational and contextual understanding of the human complexities experienced in healthcare. Coursework and experiential learning in these areas benefit pre-health students as they offer worldview depth and diversity related to how others experience and apply meaning to their healthcare experiences. This context provides students with opportunities to demonstrate soft skills such as empathy and compassion, along with other [professional competencies](#) required for admission to healthcare professional schools and interactions with future patients.

The program requires students to complete:

12 credits	Humanities and social science courses at the 3,000 level or above from the approved list . *Note: Must earn a grade of C or better and course cannot count towards your major requirements. Nine credits must be within CLAS. Three non-CLAS credits may be approved. Other courses may be considered. Please send the course number, course title, and syllabus to rknicker@advising.ufl.edu .
20 points	Experiential activities in the <i>Beyond120</i> PHS tiers during your undergraduate career.

Students may mix and match *Beyond120* courses, community service, excursions, study abroad programs, internships, and other opportunities. A variety of experiences in all three tiers will aid in developing an understanding of the professional world and the versatility of a CLAS degree. The PHS program offers support and guidance to current CLAS students so they maximize the results of their *Beyond120* experience.

Beyond120 Pre-Health Scholars are eligible to receive the following:

How Can I Earn Points?

Each tier requires a minimum number of activities to complete within that tier. You can complete more than the minimum, but must complete the minimum (at least 1 in Tier 1; at least 2 in Tier 2; at least 3 in Tier 3). You earn points by successfully completing an approved activity within each tier. If you wish to complete an activity outside of those listed in each tier, please have your activity pre-approved by the PHS Curriculum Coordinator.
