Requirements/Eligibility

- Required GPA: 3.3
- Students must have completed at least two years of study at UF (this exchange is only open to Juniors + Seniors)
- Two letters of recommendation
- Meeting with Dr. Brian Harfe, CLAS Associate Dean

Housing

With over 8,000 rooms in 19 halls, UCL offers a variety of types, costs, and locations. Much of UCL's accommodation is very near to the main University buildings and all of it is within two miles (three kilometers) of the campus. Accommodation is only guaranteed for students who are spending a full academic year at UCL, but students coming for a shorter period of time may be allocated accommodation.

Application Deadlines

Fall: early May

Academic Year: early May

Spring: mid October

Note: Some exchange programs have earlier deadlines

Tuition

Tuition at the host school is waived for exchange students, who instead pay tuition directly to the University of Florida at their usual tuition rate.

Financial Aid

University of Florida students needing financial aid should apply through UF Student Financial Affairs. Normal eligibility for aid may be used while studying abroad as an exchange student. This includes using the Bright Futures scholarship and the Florida Pre-Paid College Plan.

Scholarships

For fall, spring, and academic-year scholarships administered by the University of Florida International Center, the deadlines for application are: early March for programs starting in fall; and early October for programs starting in spring. Applications are located on the UF International Center website, www.internationalcenter.ufl.edu.

Health Insurance

Students will be billed for mandatory international health insurance which includes emergency medical assistance.

Fees Due

A \$425 non-refundable fee is required within seven days of applying online. Students who will receive financial aid may contact the University of Florida International Center to arrange deferment until the disbursement of their financial aid.
