

# UF EXCHANGE AT UNI CARLOS III (MADRID)

This program is offered for the Fall and Spring semesters and the Academic Year (Fall & Spring).



The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences offers a semester-long or year-long study abroad program at Universidad Carlos III in Madrid, Spain. Carlos III is the second highest ranked university in Spain, and is especially highly regarded in business administration, economics, law, and social sciences. It is located in the Spanish capital of Madrid, one of Europe's leading business and cultural centers. With its 6.8 million inhabitants, Madrid is the second largest metropolitan area in the European Union.

- All majors are welcome.
- Credits earned apply to UF degree and UF GPA.
- Many courses are taught in English — especially in economics, history, international relations, law, political science, and sociology.

**Host Institution** - Our exchange partner is Universidad Carlos III, a large, comprehensive public university located in Spain's capital and largest city. The university is among the most highly regarded in Spain.

**Courses** - UC3 offers an extensive list of English-taught courses. Students can select their courses from a long list of major courses in several disciplines, including economics, history, international relations, law, political science, and sociology. Many courses have already been reviewed by UF academic departments and received pre-approval for UF course equivalencies. Some sample courses include:

- Introduction to Sociology (SYG 2000)
- Comparative Politics (POS 2001)
- International Relations and Organizations (INR 2001)
- Contemporary Spain (EUH 3931)
- Markets and Environment (ECP 3302)
- Health Economics (ECP 3530)

**Accommodation** - Most exchange students live in dormitory-style residences located near the University. The UC3 International Student Center will assist with locating housing options. Students participating in the optional internship program may also secure housing through that program, which includes the option of a homestay.

**Tuition and Fees** - This is a UF exchange program. Tuition at the host school is **waived** for exchange students. Students participating in an exchange pay tuition directly to the University of Florida at their usual tuition rate. All financial aid, scholarships, and fellowships are applicable. The UF International Center charges a nonrefundable \$425 application fee. **UF students may apply Bright Futures Scholarships, Florida Pre-paid Program, and other financial aid to program costs.** The optional internship program incurs additional costs, which are not covered by UF scholarships or financial aid packages.

**Other Costs** - The average cost of living is €800-€1,200 per month. This includes housing, meals, insurance, transportation, and recreation. Students who plan to travel outside of Madrid should budget accordingly for those trips.

**Requirements** - Minimum 2.5 GPA required.
