

UF EXCHANGE AT UNI GRAZ (AUSTRIA)

This program is offered for the academic year (Fall & Spring) and Spring terms



The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences offers a semester-long or year-long study abroad program at University of Graz in Austria. Uni Graz is a large, comprehensive public university, similar to UF. The university enrolls more than 30,000 students across its 6 colleges, including the Faculties of Arts and Humanities, Business, Economic and Social Sciences, and Natural Sciences. The city of Graz is a historic, well-preserved, and student-oriented city that houses more than 60,000 university students. It is conveniently located in Central Europe and offers easy travel to Vienna, Venice, Munich, and Prague.

- All majors are welcome.
- Many courses are taught in English.
- Credits earned apply to UF degree and UF GPA.

Host Institution - Our exchange partner is the University of Graz, a large, comprehensive public university located in Austria's second largest city. With more than 30,000 students, it is Austria's largest and second-oldest university.

Courses - Uni Graz offers an extensive list of English-taught courses. Students will be able to select their courses from a long list of major courses in several disciplines, including anthropology, economics, history, sociology, and women's studies. Some sample courses include:

- Principles of Marketing
- Global Economic History
- Monetary Policy and the European Monetary Union
- Ancient History: Crafts and Services
- Gender and Migration in Globalization
- Who Needs Feminism Today: Feminist Theories and Activism

Accommodation - Most exchange students live in dormitory-style residences located near the University. The Uni Graz International Student Center will assist with locating housing.

Tuition and Fees - This is a UF exchange program. Tuition at the host school is **waived** for exchange students. Students participating in an exchange pay tuition directly to the University of Florida at their usual tuition rate. All financial aid, scholarships, and fellowships are applicable. The UF International Center charges a nonrefundable \$425 application fee. **UF students may apply Bright Futures Scholarships, Florida Pre-paid Program, and other financial aid to program costs.**

Other Costs - The average cost of living is €2600-4600 per semester. This includes housing, meals, insurance, transportation, and recreation. Students who plan to travel outside of Graz should budget accordingly for those trips.

Requirements - Minimum 2.5 GPA required.
